

Requirements and Commitment of Scoutmasters Requirements and Commitments for Scoutmasters 2010 National Jamboree

The Miami Valley Council will have three troops attending the National Jamboree in 2010. Each National Jamboree Troop will have a Scoutmaster and three Assistant Scoutmasters. Ideally the 3rd Asst Scoutmaster for each troop would be an 18-21 year old adult. The National Jamboree Scoutmasters will be selected following interviews from the Council National Jamboree Committee on June 3, 4 and 5, 2008. The deadline for all applications to be in the Scout Office is Friday, May 30, 2008. Adults should not send in the \$100.00 with the application. This will be paid when you are selected to go as a Scoutmaster.

There are only 12 positions available for Scoutmasters. The 2010 National Jamboree Committee will make every effort to select those adults who they believe will provide the best experience for the scouts. Those not selected or those not interested in a Scoutmaster position are encouraged to apply for the National Jamboree Staff.

The following guidelines for the National Jamboree Scoutmaster position include:

- Must pay the full jamboree fee. Probably around \$1500.00
 - Must attend the monthly meetings of the National Jamboree Committee
 - Must actively work to promote the jamboree opportunity to scouts.
 - Must be able to attend pre-jamboree meetings with their troops. These are normally held every few months early on and then usually monthly.
 - Must be able to attend the jamboree shake down weekend, normally held in early May.
- The committee of which the scoutmasters will be a part will try to set a date that works for everyone.

Youth interested in attending the Jamboree need to complete an application and pay the \$100 deposit. Applications are available on-line and at the Council Office. The Jamboree will be limited in space for this once in a lifetime event.
