IMPORTANT INSTRUCTIONS:

1. The individual under consideration for this award **must not be aware** of the fact that he or she is a candidate.
2. Please make certain all material is factual and in detail.
3. Any Silver Beaver nomination forms received other than this one will be returned to the person submitting the nomination and asked to resubmit using this form only.
4. Nominations cannot be made for posthumous awards.

POINTS TO CONSIDER:

1. The candidate for the award shall be a registered volunteer Scouter with the Council.
2. Must be 21 years of age or over.
3. Must have rendered noteworthy service of exceptional character to boyhood within the territory under jurisdiction of our local council. It is recognized that the nature and value of noteworthy service to boys might take the form of a single plan or various activities which vitally affected the lives of a large number of boys or that the service might be given to a small group over an extended period of time.

DESIRABLE REQUIREMENTS:

1. At least 8 years of accumulative service to boys with the greater weight given to service in Scouting.
2. That the candidate shall have experience in service to youth outside of Scouting.
3. That consideration be given of position and opportunity to render service and how this service may be regarded as outstanding or distinctive beyond the expectation of normal duty.
4. How has time and experience proven the value of the service?
5. Record of service, reputation, and standing of the candidate in the community.

All names not selected in any given year will be reviewed for consideration the following year with an update from the original nominator. A new nomination is NOT needed.
