

CAMPERSHIP PROGRAM

WHAT IS IT? The Campership Program is designed to assist Scouts and their families who need financial assistance to participate in the Miami Valley Council outdoor program.

THIS PROGRAM ASSISTS WITH THE PAYMENT OF DAY CAMP, BOY SCOUT SUMMER CAMP, AND CUB /WEBELOS RESIDENT CAMP FEES IN THE MIAMI VALLEY COUNCIL. IT DOES NOT COVER FEES FOR TROOPS ATTENDING SUMMER CAMPS OUT OF COUNCIL.

APPLICATION:

1. A Scout's **parent / guardian** or **unit leader** may submit the Campership request and mail or bring to: Miami Valley Council, BSA

2. The Council may award up to **50% of the total Scout camp participation fee** *(see list on form for fee corresponding to the particular camp you are applying for). **Amount of campership depends on the availability of funds; therefore, total request may not be awarded.**
2. **"A Scout is thrifty"**, therefore all boys that receive a campership are asked to do a good turn for his church, school, or chartered organization. Boys unable to find a project are invited to participate in the Council's **"Beaver Day"** Camp Improvement Day, **May 3** at Woodland Trails or **Cookout for Scouting** on **June 13** downtown Dayton.
3. **Camp fee deadlines still apply to boys applying for assistance.** Check below for deadline dates.
4. The application form for camperships **must** be filled out **COMPLETELY** and **SIGNED BY THE SCOUTMASTER** in order for the application to be **accepted**. **Please use a separate form for each Scout. (For example, if a Scout goes to both Cub Resident Camp and Day Camp we request that you submit a form for each boy for each camp).**
6. Applications are due **April 11th**. (All applications will be reviewed and awarded on a first come first serve basis).

1. May 15, 2008 All District Day Camps
2. *May 2, 2008 Fees for Boy Scout Summer Camp
(Webelos crossing over after May 5th will be due June 10th).
3. * June 6, 2008 Cub Resident Camp
4. * June 6, 2008 Webelos Resident Camp
