Definition of Uniform terms occasionally used in Scouting: (Not official BSA terms but used by many in Scouting)

**Class A's = First five items on list.**

**Class B's = Items 2-5 with a Bear Claw Scouting T-shirt.**

*Note: Bear Claw will use the official Scout Uniform only during the week, the first \* five is required dress before moving to the campsite. Three Bear Claw T-shirts will be provided; we will wear the Class B uniform most of the time with a Bear Claw T-shirt. We suggest you put your name on all your personal items. A backpack must be used for transporting your gear from the registration area to your campsite. Participants will carry there backpack/personal equipment. Participants must not use suitcases, footlockers, or trunks at the campsite. Normal prescribed patrol equipment will be issued. Cots (marked with full name) will be transported by the Quartermaster's staff to the patrol sites.*
